

Update Letter – Wednesday 5th August 2020

Dear all,

Zara and I have really enjoyed and be inspired by the teaching and worship from the New Wine United Breaks Out summer conference over the weekend – and we hope you have too. I felt a real sense of the theme of **hope** throughout the weekend – a hope in Jesus in this season and forever but also a hope that the Church will be fired up, prayed up and sent out into the world in a new and powerful way to share the good news of Jesus with all in our communities and world! Services in Church resuming

We are delighted to announce that we'll be opening up our building for Sunday services once again for a simple 9am communion service each week from 6th September. In the lead up to this, we will be doing a full risk assessment and putting in a number of measures to keep us COVID secure.

As you may be aware, the guidance continues to change and the latest rules include the wearing of masks being mandatory. We understand if this puts you off but sadly we must keep to the

guidance. Other features will include 2m social distancing, a shorter service, no singing, limited numbers and communion in one kind (bread only). Whist we will be taking every precaution necessary, we want to create a space for us to worship together as community back in the Church building - for those who feel able and willing to attend. To enable us to be ready to open, a cleaning morning has been arranged for **Tuesday 1st September** at 9:30am coordinated by Jenny Plimer. If you would be available to assist with this, please contact her for more details.

Please note that we are not planning to stop our 10:30am online service and there will be some extra online provision aimed specifically at Children and families coming as well. Please do pray for us in this season as we move to physical services in the building alongside continuing the online services too.
